Competition closes on 27th November at Midday.



Design Specifications:

Submitted designs can be photography, graphics or artwork but they must be original and belong to the entrant.

Entries must be submitted as a jpeg or InDesign file in high resolution (at least 300dpi)

The finished card will be printed in A5 (A4 half-fold) either portrait or landscape. Exact dimensions are: $297 \text{mm} \times 210 \text{mm}$, or $303 \text{mm} \times 216 \text{mm}$ with <u>bleed</u>

If submitting a graphic, set your <u>colour mode</u> as CMYK and embed or flatten your <u>fonts</u>
